Exercise 5.6 (Oxford Book 1)

1. Flaccus et filius in **agro** (*ablative*) laborant.
Flaccus and his son are working in the field.
2. Puellae in **via** (*ablative*) ludunt. Scintilla eas in **casam** (*accusative*) vocat.
The girls are playing in the road. Scintilla calls them into the house.
3. Flaccus pueros ad **agrum** (*accusative*) ducit.
Flaccus leads the boys to the field.
4. Multae puellae cum [**femina / feminis**] (*ablative*) ad fontem ambulant.
Many girls walk to the spring with the [woman / women].
5. Puer cum [**amico / amicis**] (*ablative*) ad **ludum** (*accusative*) festinat.
The boy hurries to school with his [friend / friends].
