## Homework #4 Answers

### Exercise 7.2 (Oxford Book 1)

6. Graeci [**navem / naves**] (*nominative*) defendere non possunt.  
**The Greeks are not able to defend their [ship / ships].**
7. Patroclus cum **omnibus** (*ablative*) **comitibus** (*ablative*) in pugnam currit.  
**Patroclus runs into battle with all his comrades.**
8. **Omnes** (*nominative*) Troiani in **urbem** (*accusative*) fugiunt.  
**All the Trojans flee into the city.**
9. Hector in **urbem** (*accusative*) non fugit sed **Patroclum** (*accusative*) oppugnat.  
**Hector does not flee into the city, but attacks Patroclus.**
10. **Hastam** (*accusative*) iacit et **Patroclum** (*accusative*) occidit.  
**He throws a spear and kills Patroclus.**
