5. Multi **principum** (*3rd declension plural*) in urbem fugere cupiunt.
Many of princes want to flee into the city.
6. Pauci **Troianorum** (*2nd declension plural*) fortiter pugnant.
Few of the Trojans fight bravely.
7. Hector ter fugit circum muros **urbis** (*3rd declension singular*)
Hector flees around the walls of the city three times.
8. Omnes Toiani **Hectoris** (*3rd declension singular*) mortem lugent
All of the Trojans mourn the death of Hector.
